**50/17** **MINUTES**

**51/17** **PROCEDURAL MATTER** The meeting was adjourned at 7.32pm to allow the public open forum.

**52/17** **PUBLIC OPEN FORUM** Member of public reported that despite the improved broadband speeds for some parishioners, he continued to have problems with poor connection and speed - BT Openreach continued its attempts to resolve the dropping connection.

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Cllr. Mrs Russell reported concerns that 1] the line had been fenced across near the tunnel entrance and 2] a tape had been stretched across the line at ankle height. Agreed Clerk to inform Borough Council.

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- b) NYMNP consulting on way forward for next Local Plan (*details emailed 23/10/17 to all councillors, booklet circulated with agenda*). Councillors agreed responses to each question in the booklet & those responses will be submitted to the NYMNP by the Clerk. A proposal by NYMNP to list the Parish Field in Staintondale (ref. SDALE-CS-02) as a community space was robustly debated - some felt it should remain as a community space since it could be used by the village show, others felt the land should continue to be held by the Parish Council for the good of the community (which in the future could mean some of the land was used to build affordable housing for parishioners). The Chairman proposed SDALE-CS-02 and its designation of community space be removed from the NYMNP Undeveloped & Community Spaces Map dated 4/10/17. A recorded vote was taken (FOR Cllrs. James, Russell and Terry, AGAINST Cllrs. Broadhurst and Darrington). **Motion carried.**

- c) Boundary Commission review of SBC electoral wards – proposal to move both wards of the parish from Scalby Hackness & Staintondale Ward to a new ward called Fylingdales and Ravenscar (*details circulated with agenda*). **Agreed** no objections.
- d) Correspondence received after 11/11/2017 & requiring a response before next meeting – 1] **noted** letter from NYCC confirming Cllrs. Malton, Thompson and Wild had been co-opted to the Coast and Moors Area Committee until the first meeting of the committee after the Annual NYCC meeting in May 2018.
